HISTORY

A small non-profit visual arts group was established in the late 1960's by a handful of local artists for the enjoyment of the citizens of Nassau County and its visitors. Artists met to paint at the town Recreation Center, and Attorney Daniel McCranie invited the artists to exhibit their work in the Old Schoolhouse building on Atlantic Avenue.

At the same time, Robert Lannon, a local woodcarver, shop owner, and former shrimp boat captain coordinated a sidewalk Arts & Crafts Show to coincide with the annual "Shrimp Boat Races" in early May. These took place as the festivities accompanying the small, traditional, ecumenical blessing of the Shrimp Fleet at the beginning of each shrimp season. The art show at that time was so small, that it was held around the old downtown Chamber of Commerce building!

As fuel costs began to soar in the early 1970s, the shrimp boat races ceased because it became too expensive and risky to continue to race the commercial boats, and the annual show, "Shrimp Boat Races", became the "Shrimp Festival". By then the art show was going strong, and other activities were added to compensate for no longer racing the shrimp boats.

In 1976, a formal charter was drawn establishing the Amelia Island Arts and Crafts Association to manage the Arts and Crafts section of the Shrimp Festival. The first gallery of this association was established in 1979 on the second floor of Allen's Department Store on Centre Street. It's near where Partin's Shoe Store was for many years and today is Caldwell Bankers. It was called "The Upstairs Gallery."

Before the end of 1979, however, this gallery had moved again to a location on Centre Street between 2nd and 3rd Streets. Thanks to the artistic appreciation and continued support of the Dickens family this new location became the gallery's home for twenty-two years.

Bylaws were written by Marshall Brainard, the husband of one of the early members, that was finalized and approved by the members in 1982. The Island Art Association was created.

As IAA continues to grow, we all look forward to the exciting changes in our future.
