

Thank you for your interest in adding a new medium as an exhibiting member of the Island Art Association! Your application has been received. We are excited to view your art.

We are accepting your jury pieces on **Nov. 1, 2019 from 1-3 p.m.** Jurying will take place on Nov. 2, 2019 in the Art Education Center at the Gallery (the newer building at the back of the courtyard). Jurying is closed session for jurors only. **Plan to pick up your artwork between noon and 1 p.m. on Nov. 2, 2019.** If you cannot adhere to this schedule, please have a close friend or family member bring in your art work and/or pick it up. We do not have space to hold your entries prior to or after the jury session.

A. Please be sure each piece is labeled on the back of your 2D piece or the bottom of your 3D piece with your Name, Medium, Size, Title.

B. Please complete and bring with you the attached listing of your artwork. See page 3 of this attachment.

C. If you have signed your name on your piece as artist, please cover it (as best you can with paper or tape) to protect your identity for jurying. Your pieces will be assigned a number for jurying.

Your artwork will be judged on several factors: Composition, Craftsmanship, Design, Originality, Presentation, and Skill in Medium. Six examples of the new medium are required. Please complete the attached form listing the titles of each piece for the medium and take it with your art to the jurying session. Keep in mind that one medium may be accepted while another may not be accepted. Also, note that each artist receives one exhibit space for all mediums, not one space per medium.

You will be notified no later than Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2019 of the jury results. Information will be limited to whether or not you are accepted. Scores/comments are not shared. Results are confidential and final. There are no appeals.
